**26/8 Play area** - play inspection completed, some small parts are needed, Clerk to contact Proludic to enquire about ordering, Cllr Llewellyn will speak to residents regarding the fences of the play area, the algae on play equipment was noted and needs cleaning. Cllr Harris volunteered to clean it.

**26/9 Grass Cutting** – leaf collection from Quarhill to village hall path was every 3 weeks, is now included with the other more regular areas. Clerk to ask if the paths by the park walls can be prioritised if not reduced the Quarhill to village hall path back to 3 weekly.

**26/10 Correspondence** - none

**26/11 Any other business** - The overgrown bushes by Radbone hill are very dangerous as they are on the corner growing into the road. This issue is on fix my street which states the residents have been contacted.

Query regarding Village Hall funds and what happens if the budget isn't spent. Cllrs agreed that the village hall Charity should approach the council if they are unable to afford an expense. Otherwise they should self-fund. Any village hall budget not spent will be moved into earmarked to build funds for potential larger repairs.

To apply for S106 money we will need quotes for the projects we want to do.

We have a quote for the parking for the play area.

Cllrs Pashley and Cllr C Harrison to contact Solid to get report to find out what is needed for the subsidence issues with the village hall, and to look for quotes.

Cllr Pashley to obtain a quote for redoing the pavement on the 3400 to roundabout.

Clerk to obtain quote for buying play area.
